Behaviour Principles Written Statement

Manor Farm Community Junior School and its Governors seek to create an environment in the school that encourages and reinforces good behaviour. We expect mutual respect of all pupils and adults and aim to develop self-discipline in our pupils and believe that good behaviour is an important outcome of children's education.

Aims

- To create an environment that encourages and reinforces good behaviour.
- To ensure the safety and well-being of all pupils, staff and visitors.
- Teach pupils that actions have consequences.
- To define acceptable standards of behaviour.
- To encourage consistency of response to both positive and negative behaviour through clear expectations and fairness.
- To ensure that all pupils are listened to and treated with equal respect.
- To ensure positive motivational strategies are employed and anti-social behaviour discouraged.
- To promote self-esteem, self-discipline and positive relationships.
- To encourage de-escalation rather than confrontation.
- To ensure that the school's expectations and strategies are widely known and understood.
- To encourage the involvement of both home and school in the implementation of this policy.
